Processing Student Applications

- It's FREE for students to apply and there is NO LIMIT on the number of applications you can submit.
- **Verify applications are complete.** Confirm information is correct and complete on each application including the two essays on the back.
- **Verify all three required signatures are present on front and back (school, student and legal guardian).** If any part is not complete, return to student for completion.
- **All completed applications may be mailed or scanned to PFEW.** With our rolling acceptance, we encourage you to mail/email completed applications as you receive them. **DO NOT HOLD UNTIL DEADLINES!**

- **Host a PFEW Rep at your school.** Contact our offices to book a visit at your school and share the PFEW opportunity with all of your sophomores and juniors. A visit is FREE and our Rep does all the work! Open to all classes that have 10th and/or 11th graders, not just business!
- **Distribute applications to all Sophomores and Juniors.** Feel free to make copies of the enclosed applications or contact our offices for more. We highly encourage students to apply online at www.pfew.org as online applications are processed much faster. Those that apply online must print the required signature pages which must then be submitted to PFEW upon completion.
- **Hang poster.** Place your name in the white space so students know who to see for more information and where to pick up applications. Display in areas with lots of foot traffic.
- **Make announcements, send email blasts and publish articles.** Share information and applications with your whole school. List PFEW on your school website, publish an article in your school newspaper or send out an email blast to help spread the word to those you may not have in class or who are unfamiliar with PFEW.
- **Tell your colleagues.** PFEW is open to all current sophomores and juniors! Share our information with other educators at your school and in your community so their students can take advantage of all PFEW has to offer. We welcome all public, private, parochial, cyber, charter and home school students in Pennsylvania.
