Since 1979, Pennsylvania Free Enterprise Week (PFEW) has inspired students to embrace the principles of business, entrepreneurship, and the American free enterprise system. Each summer, this statewide program hosts

over 1,800 high school students for a transformative weeklong experience on the campuses of Lycoming College and Pennsylvania College of Technology in Williamsport, PA.

Through hands-on activities, dynamic speakers and a PFEW Reality Fair, PFEW equips students with critical skills like teamwork, leadership, and financial literacy while preparing them for the workforce. The Stock Market Game™ (SMG) provides an engaging, in-class simulation of global capital markets for students in grades 4-12. Student teams conduct research, create investment portfolios, and invest \$100,000 in virtual cash FOUNDATION in real securities in real time using an

online platform. As they compete against peers for the highest return, students develop critical thinking, teamwork and decision-making skills and unlock doors to successful financial futures.

By connecting classroom learning to real-world applications, SMG



equips students with lifelong skills that will serve them in college, careers, and beyond. Your support ensures more students can benefit from this innovative program, creating a brighter future for generations to come.



The Speaker Series is an innovative workforce development and career exploration program that has generated thousands of student views since 2020. These 15-30-minute interview-style videos offer real-world

insights into various professions, helping students develop professional mentor relationships while connecting them with local scholarship, internship, and professional development opportunities. This program provides students with the practical career exploration tools they need to succeed in the workforce.

### Why Are These Programs Needed?


