After a three-year battle with Alzheimer's disease, Jim passed away peacefully on June 10th, 2020, but his lasting impact is his kindness, caring and unfailing generosity. Kitchen Magic is a true family business. Renate's brother-in-law Brett Bacho serves as president and CEO, sister Cindy Purcell is VP of Customer Experience, sister Lotte is VP of HR and Accounting, and Brett's brother, Chad Bacho, is the company's IT Director. The family is fond of saying that Kitchen Magic became the venture that 'stuck'.

Renate attended Drew University in Madison, NJ, looking toward a career in journalism, which didn't quite go as planned. She returned to work in the family business after college, then stepped away for a decade and entered the retail furniture business. Later, as a single mom with three small children at home, she shifted gears again and became an independent marketing consultant. When Kitchen Magic became a client, so began her journey back home.

Kitchen Magic knows the company is only as good as its people. They are passionate about teaching employees to think like business people, so they adopted the 'Great Game of Business' developed by Jack Stack and run the business using open book management. Monthly expenses and earnings are shared with employees who actively manage and forecast expenses in each department, from manufacturing to marketing.

When the team wins together, everyone shares in the profits or 'gainshare'. In 2020, despite being shut down for twelve weeks during COVID, Kitchen Magic was able to pay out significant and much needed gainshare to employees. Renate says the best part is, they earned it together.
